 - There will not be a band clinic this year – opens up 3/3 date.

8. Old Business:
 - Fundraising –
 - Krispy Kreme sales - Melody Bidtah can do 1/27 or 2/3. Consensus to do 2/3 to gives more time to pre-sell
 - 4 students per shift outside the Mercantile on Saturday
 - Melody can pick up the donuts Saturday and make them available at the site sale.
 - Need parents to man 2 hour shifts at the Mercantile to hand out pre-sales. If items aren't picked up by certain time, available for site sales.
 - Melody will put up sign up sheet. 4 kids per shift, at least 1 adult.
 - Donuts will be sold for \$12/box.
 - Applebees – Karyn Crawford 2/4 – if we have leftover donuts, may be able to sell at Applebees.
 - No signups yet. Need 10 kids per shift.
 - Need to sell tickets – this is a pre-sale event.
 - Will put them out at concessions at Buc for a Day & parent meeting.
 - Kids can be fundraising for next year's trip and/or band camp.

 - 50% return
 - \$10 per ticket
 - January 29th due date for reporting sold tickets – need Mr. Guenther to email re signups.
 - Will set up signup genius for kids to volunteer
 - Ferry sales – CBs Nuts (40 cases this time- did 20 last time and very successful)
 - Can do 2 per year
 - We're starting fresh now (1 in Spring & can decide later if we want to do 1 in summer or fall)
 - 3/31 is our first choice for the date
 - Popcorn - Steve needs orders info back
 - Can KHSBB keep a board in the classroom for kids to pick up and drop off forms? Mr. Guenther is going to check if that's ok.
 - Rummage Sale – Gina proposed that we could reserve a venue for indoor sales, divide space for kids selling, kids staff and collect sales. Kids then have to clean up unsold items.
 - Considering March 3/30 Friday morning/Saturday at Miller Bay Estates clubhouse.
 - Can do concessions at same time for general fund or include a raffle.
 - KHSBB would charge each family a booth fee.
 - Checking with Village Green to see costs/date.
