1. Call to order: 6:38 p.m.
2. Thank you to Kim for pulling things together and Melody for taking on individual sales, Karmenn for butterbraid and membership, Virginia for handling basketball concessions, Karen for Applebees breakfast, Steve and Gina for coordinating the trip.

9. Committee Reports:
  - Trip (Steve)
    - Some parents lacking communications
    - First payments must be made January 6<sup>th</sup> for flights
    - 25 kids and 7 adults signed up so far
10. Old Business:
  - Fundraising –
    - CBs nuts sale at ferry was highly successful and should be repeated. Local, inexpensive, good return on the effort, repeatable once per calendar year
    - (Karen) Applebees flapjack fundraiser,
      - We are scheduled for Superbowl Sunday, February 4<sup>th</sup>, 8am to 10am
      - \$10 per ticket, all included breakfast. We get \$5 per ticket.
      - All pre-sale because we have to give them a headcount on Monday.
      - Signout method of selling tickets with individually numbered tickets.
      - Karen will sell tickets tomorrow night at the concert.
      - 200 tickets, which matches Applebees capacity for those eating at one time
      - Tips will go into a pool
      - Donation bucket by door
      - Raffle baskets per section
      - Could do a 50/50 raffle at end of 2 hours

- Need 10 kids to serve, but kids could also play instruments
- Melody is arranging a Krispy Kreme pre-sale
- Table at the concert for sales and trip paperwork, set up between 6 and 6:30pm
  - Butterbraids will also be at concert tomorrow with Karmenn

11. New Business:

- Kids have asked for a banquet opportunity
- Karmenn mentioned that schools used to do a concert night for acts competing in solo/ensemble
- We could hold meeting for incoming 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents to give them KHSBB info before they pick them up from Buck for a day. Can get Jeff Haag to email about it.
  - Will prepare Band Camp packet in time for the meeting
  - Talk to them about how to get PE waiver through marching and handle Health class outside of school
- Kids have also asked Guenther if Band Camp can be more than field show, allowing kids to come even if not going to participate in field show
- Field show discussion regarding viability of field show competition; local schools are dropping it, doing non-competitive field show for events & half-time at football games; parents expressed that Auburn is a positive experience and kids really enjoy watching the other bands; per Mr. Guenther, no decision at this time; maybe add a lower key competition in Tenino that is 3 weeks before Auburn.
